Amanda Hope Rainbow Angels was able to provide Comfy Cozy gifts and room decorations, in the transplant room, for 13 children who have just received cancer treatment and other life-threatening diseases. These decorations provided distraction and comfort as well as reducing anxiety, allowing the procedure the child is going through to have the best potential for success.

Who were the beneficiaries? The 13 children and their families that received the Comfy Cozy gifts and room decorations in their transplant room.

Additionally, whenever transplant rooms are decorated, it spreads the word to other cancer patients about Amanda Hope.
