The Whittier Regional Symphony is the organizer of the concert.

Whittier Sunrise members will assist in managing the arrival and departure of the buses and will serve as ushers to provide assistance to school and symphony staff during the concert. This project has grown to include a close association of the Whittier Sunrise RC with the Whittier Regional Symphony Association. The Symphony Association presents four free concerts each season to the general public. Club members are now in charge of the disabled parking for those concerts. Five to six club members assisted by students from the California HS interact, direct parking and assist disabled seniors from the vehicles to their seats in the auditorium. Two of our members now serve on the board of the Whittier Regional Symphony.

7. **Describe how funds will be safeguarded and tracked** (*If funds are to be distributed to a partner in Mexico who will be responsible for the funds? How will transfers of funds to Mexico be handled?*):

Funds from the district will be deposited in the Whittier Sunrise RC account and dispersed from that account to the Whittier Regional Symphony Association which contracts with the transportation vendors and other service providers.

8. **Describe how your club will use the project funds (list the types of expenses / items to be purchased)**:

Assuming that the concert in 2024 can be held in the usual format, the funds will be used for transportation for the students from the school to the concert venue. That is the current plan by the Symphony Association. However, it is possible that alternative means of providing this experience will be necessary in January. We will work with the Symphony Association to support any such adjustments.
