We hand packed 4 different freeze-dried foods into packets that had to be weighed for accuracy, then sealed, labeled and crated into boxes ready for oversees shipping. Volunteers also help set up the room being used and helped breakdown / clean up after.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

We were a part of a nationwide packaging event with over 331,000 volunteers packaging over 57.4 million meals. Those meals serve more than 3.6 million people in over 37 countries, most of which are not likely to be Rotarians.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Create a path to self reliance for last-mile communities.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Rise Against Hunger is growing a global movement to end hunger by nourishing lives, empowering communities and responding to emergencies. Targeting remote, last-mile communities within hunger pockets designated "serious" or higher by the Global Hunger Index, we work with local leaders to harness the strengths of their communities and tackle their own food and nutrition security challenges with agency, dignity and resilience.
