There has been very high absenteeism among junior and senior high school students in Estes Park. To motivate students to attend school, Estes Valley Sunrise Rotary helped local high school junior and senior students with paint for their own parking stalls.

This allows students to express themselves while also building Teamwork, Pride and Self-esteem and a sense of worth within the Student. Having the freedom and creative liberty to your very own parking stalls is one thing that seems to always pump-up students, even if they would not necessarily consider themselves an artist.
