On May 20, 2025 members of our club presented the water safety program, Josh the Otter, to students at John S. Malcolm School in Laguna Niguel. The presentation included interaction with Josh the Otter (a member in a mascot costume), the reading of the Josh the Otter book, giving out books and coloring books to students, and teaching the students the Josh the Otter song. There was a discussion on water safety.

The Program included Rotarians passing out books, interacting with students, discussing water safety with students, and dressing up in the mascot costume to get students excited about water safety.
