The grant has provided 32 e-books at each school (Capri and Paul Ecke Central) all focused on science and engineering. Every student K-3 has access to the high interest science books simultaneously, if desired. Teachers are able to use the books for whole class, small group or individual reading. All digital books purchased are interactive which allows students to mark words they want to remember and take digital notes. Students access the books on iPads which they take home, allowing parents to participate in the interactive content of the digital books. Rotarians have been involved in the literacy program.

4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects:

This was an exciting grant to be involved in, since the schools have not purchased e-Books before. The EUSD Technology Department and e-Book vendor helped teachers understand the best way to access the books. The Rotary Club of Encinitas is very proud to have been part of this pioneering effort of offering digital books as an alternative for students. As a result of the grant, Encinitas Rotary has strengthened our partnership with the school community. We have come a long way since the days of purchasing paperback dictionaries for third graders. Now e-books have digital dictionaries embedded.
