

Global Grant Proposal to upgrade the Neo-natal Care ward at the Government Hospital,
Tiruchengode, Tamilnadu, India

Following is the statistics from which we could understand the desperate requirement for the equipment envisaged in the proposal. Many times it has happened that some babies who have not recovered fully have to be shifted out from respiratory support in order to accommodate more critically ill babies. And it has also happened many times that the babies have been referred out to Hospitals in nearby big towns like Erode for want of adequate respiratory support equipment. Our endeavour is to augment the capacity of the Hospital with ample respiratory support system to treat the needy babies. Our proposed new capacity addition will be able to help around 300 – 400 babies year after year and save their lives.
