We are an organization that promotes the economic and social development of women and their communities.


Vision

- 20 years ago, Marshall Saunders, past president of Coronado Rotary Club, founded Grameen de la Frontera in Huatabampo, Sonora.
- **Grameen** is a <u>microfinance</u> organization and community development bank founded in Bangladesh. It makes small loans, known as microcredit to the impoverished without requiring collateral.
- **Grameen Bank** originated in 1976, in the work of Professor Muhammad Yunus at University of Chittagong, who launched a <u>research project</u> to study how to design a credit delivery system to provide banking services to the rural poor.
- In 2006, the bank and its founder, Muhammad Yunus, were jointly awarded the Nobel Peace Prize.




Objetivo general

- Mobile library (Activities to promote stories and reading).
- Leveling and homework club (Reading and math).
- Flag football and other sports.
- Summer Camp.
- Recreation spaces.







MEEN SITUACIÓN ACTUAL

Currently operates 1 mobile classroom in the community of Agua Blanca in partnership with a local company





- 100 children benefited
- 190 sessions of academic leveling taught (570 hours)
- 50 sessions of robotics and programming (equivalent to 150 hours)
- Development of the first summer camp (200 hours)
