

Municipality Map




Water Source



Need Assessment Result

- There is old drinking water system built some 25 years ago but due to lack of maintenance & landslides it hardly works.
- They have used plastic pipe of ½ inch to bring water from 6 Kms distance for
 10 public drinking water which hardly fulfill their requirement.
- Tanks built 25 years ago cannot hold the water for long time & it is un repariable
- People consume water directly from source no physical & chemical filtration
- They use same water for drinking, bathing, washing & cattle cleaning purpose
- If project is carried out, people contribute can contribute physically
- People can project the drinking water pipeline
- People are ready to pay NRs.150 (\$1.5) every month for repairing purpose
