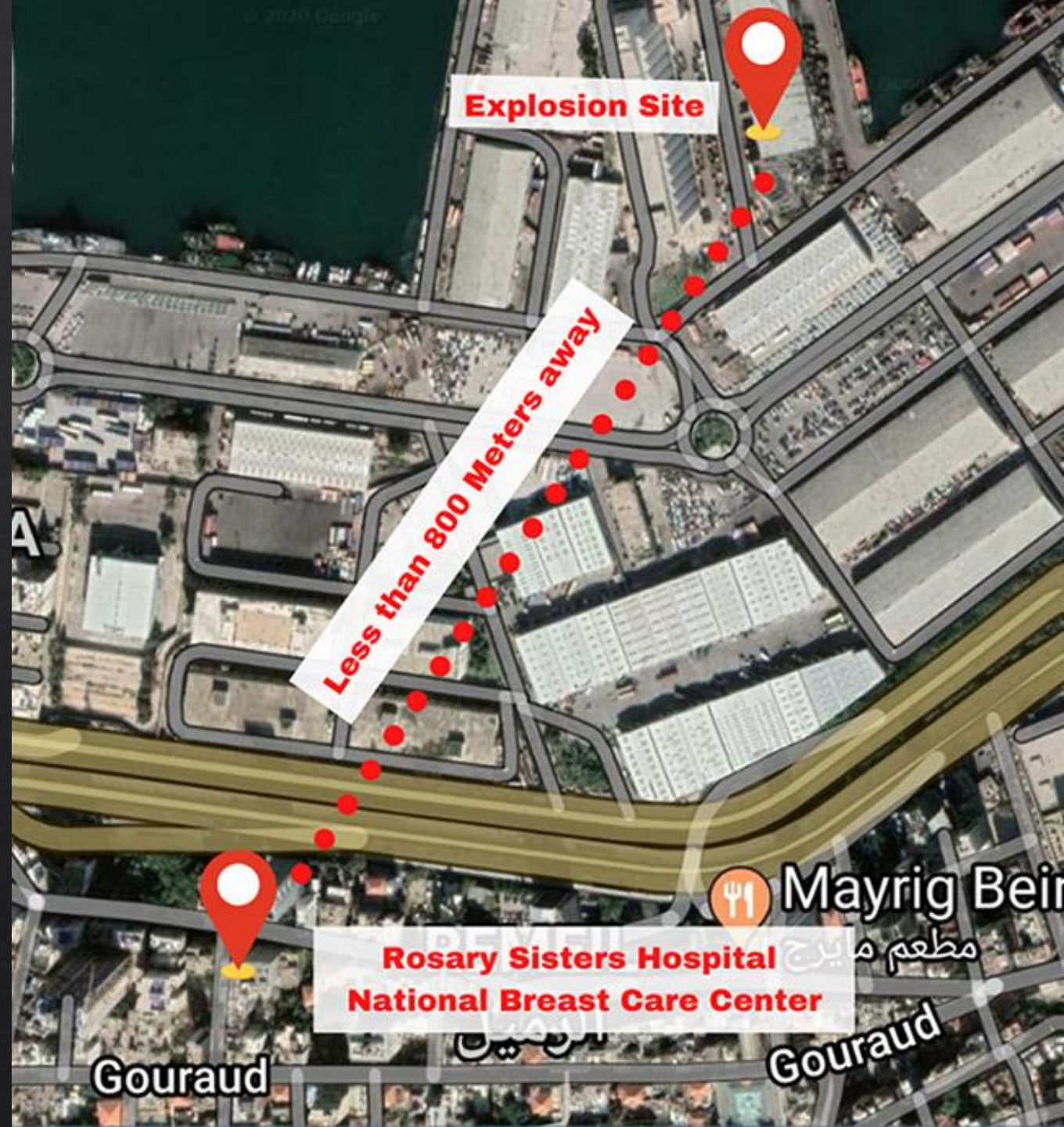


Hopital Des Sœurs Du Rosaire,

## Before this tragedy...

- ◆ The hospital had been completely renovated and modernized, and it houses:
  - ◆ National Breast Care Center
  - ◆ Vision and Ophthalmology Institute
  - ◆ Women's Care Center
  - ◆ Obstetrics and Gynecology
- ◆ The hospital employs 160 staff and 140 physicians.
