AREA OF FOCUS: Disease Prevention and Treatment.
Maternal and Child Health.

PROJECT LOCATION: Zone 3, Wuse District, FCT – Abuja.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Purchase and Donation of a fully equipped Ambulance to Wuse District Hospital, Wuse Zone 3, FCT Abuja to ease movement of patients during emergencies to and from referral hospitals.

The Ambulance will also be kitted with PPE to aid evacuation of Covid-19 related cases.

SUSTAINABILITY:

- The Wuse General Hospital customarily collects fees for the use of its ambulance. The practice will continue for the collection of a pool of funds and the trained personnel will be deployed for the maintenance and routine operation of the ambulance.
- The Club has a periodic supervision clause in the MOU, that the Club is at liberty to do a supervision check on the Ambulance without notice to the Hospital Management, so as to ensure adequate maintenance and utility of the vehicle.
- The Ambulance will be insured against all unforeseen issues.
- In summary, the project will be self-sustaining as operating cost will be charged to users. This cost will be far cheaper than what the few available public Ambulances charged presently in the city.
