The schools are public schools and the communities are deprived and congested urban and rural communities within the Sunyani Municipal Areas of the Bono Region, Ghana. The Sunyani Municipality is about 90% urbanized with an estimated population of about 300,000 people. However, the communities and schools at the fringes of the city and the congested inner areas face serious challenges with access




to water and sanitation services. This is harming the quality of life, affecting negatively on the teaching, and learning in the schools. The Rotary Club of Sunyani-Central has received several
