The trust set up 59 bedded Hospital at Plot No.57, Sector 15A, Vashi, and Navi Mumbai in a 5 storeyed structure of approx. 30,000 sq. ft. PKC Hospital commenced operation in 1995 and is a multi-specialty Hospital. The Registration No. of the trust is F-1050. Over the years the hospital has grown through internal resources and donations received from its members. The motto of the Trust is to serve the public. The Trust charges patients a nominal amount and its capability to fund its growth has been possible due to the benevolent donors from time to time. The hospital offers best of facilities in its class in the various departments including: PATHOLOGY, RADIOLOGY, CARDIOLOGY, OBSTETRICS & GYNAECOLOGY, OPHTHAMOLOGY, RETINA SPECIALITY, PEDIATRICS, KNEE AND HIP REPLACEMENT, HAND AND MICROSURGERY, GENERAL SURGERY, ONCOLOGY, GASTRO INTESTINAL, NEUROLOGY, NEPHROLOGY, PHYSIOTHERAPY, ENT, DENTAL, LAPAROSCOPIC SURGERY, PULMONOLOGY AND DERMATOLOGY.

The Hospital has from time to time upgraded its facilities and brought in latest equipment and with the generosity of donors we continue to support & help needy patients. In field of ophthalmology we have a well-equipped OPD and OT with latest diagnostic and treatment tools including Phaco machine. We have team of and Dr. experienced, well trained ophthalmic surgeons Dr. Ruchira Sharma, Dr. Trupti Pandhare, Dr. Saurabh Dhewale and Dr. Abhimanyu Gadakh. OPD patients and 30 surgical procedures every month. The costs are affordable and free for people who need that support.

At present we are referring patients to government hospital Mumbai or private hospitals in city, requiring Retinal detachment surgery, Diabetic Retinal disease, Macular holes surgery. Availability of Posterior segment surgery equipment would enable us to provide wide variety of surgical treatments saving eyes of many needy patients. We would treat at least 10 to 15 needy patients every month with gradual increase in numbers over period of time.

To further enhance our ophthalmology services, we require a well-equipped Retina setup, including a Vitrectomy Machine. This will enable us to conduct advanced retinal surgeries and expand the number of procedures as our reach grows.
