2. Name of District Grant: Oceanside Youth Development Program
3. Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred: Increase literacy and cultural development for children grades K-12 in Oceanside's disadvantaged Crown Heights area by providing books, reading and school attendance incentives, mentorship, and leadership development and training. We had to make two changes in the grant: we were unable to schedule a leadership training session for the high school, so instead we provided funds for high school graduation incentives in partnership with North County Lifeline, who have a "stay-in-school" program for Crown Heights kids. And we spent less on the middle school mentorship program, so we sponsored Mission San Luis Rey's essay contest for 4<sup>th</sup> graders.
4. Lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded project: we learned that we need to arrange for outside participation (such as leadership training) in advance of the grant, so that we have all our "ducks in a row" for executing the grant. We also learned that we need to schedule everything to be completed by 1 April, which was a surprise this year.
