1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Mission Viejo Rotary club has sponsored the Door of faith Orphanage in Mexico since 1988. We have been in constant communication with the Orphanage throughout the years with various projects and were informed by the District staff at the Rotary Foundation training that a participating Mexican Rotary Club would not be necessary. With over 130 children and 20 voluntary staff the kitchen was in dire need of a new oven/range and low burners and large pots (final cost \$4,741.00). they were also in need of two new washing machines with as many as thirty loads done daily(final cost \$1,847.70)). In addition the children are required to wear uniforms in order to attend school and church (final cost \$4,331.54).

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

At least 10 members of the club went down to the Orphanage at various times during the project.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

The members helped supervise the purchase of the various equipment, during this period attended the vision eyecare project. This included helping the eye doctors and physicians exam the majority of the children, plus provide free eyewear necessary for clear vision.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

The 130 children and staff living at the Door of Faith Orphanage

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

This project allows the Orphanage to provide proper care, sustenance and education to the children that live there that otherwise would be a burden on the community.

If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?Some church organization helped pay the balance of funds needed to complete this project.
