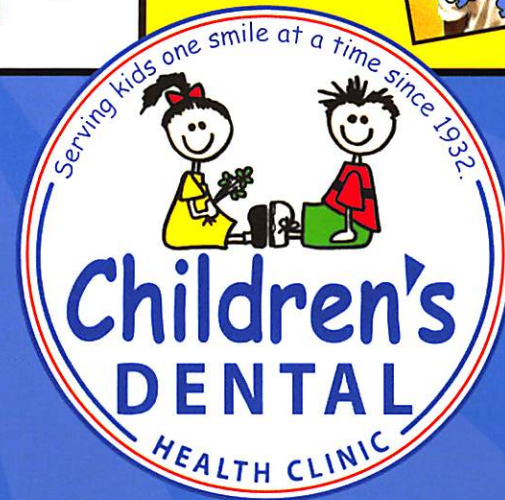

We have dedicated this annual report to our superheroes. No, not the ones on screens and in comic books; we're cheering for our patients and their families. Being hospital-based, we see a fair amount of patients with complex medical and physical needs. Many need to overcome substantial obstacles to do the things we take for granted.

A superhero patient I'd like to highlight is Lisa. Unlike the genes of most babies, she was born with an additional 21st chromosome or trisomy as they are usually in pairs. This condition, named after the British physician John Langdon Down, has become known as Down Syndrome. At the Children's Dental Health Clinic, we see many patients a week that have this syndrome. Though there is often some mental impairment, many also have associated heart, vision, hearing and dental problems. Lisa was referred to us as a cheerful six year old. Her parents both worked but adjusted their schedules so that someone was always home to help Lisa. Unfortunately, in these younger years, they used candy as a reward system. While this was a positive aid in her behavior, it produced extensive carious-diseased teeth (cavities). Due to her behavior and multiple health issues, her pediatrician agreed that it would be best if we treated her under general anesthesia in the hospital operating room.

Once safely induced and monitored, we were able to complete a comprehensive exam, x-rays and all of her restorative work. Though we had returned her mouth to a healthy, disease-free state, our bigger challenge was to meet with Lisa and her parents to discuss her diet, oral hygiene and how to develop a new reward system that did not include candy. This process was not easy and took time. Our clinical staff remained committed and so did Lisa's parents. At seven years old, her check-up revealed just one new cavity. We were able to take care of this in our main clinic without sedation. Her oral health and habits had improved but our common goal was no cavities. By her 8th birthday, we involved her school, asking her teacher (of a special needs classroom) to include tooth brushing after lunch. We saw Lisa again just after her 9th birthday, she was all smiles when we told her that she had no cavities! On this visit, she received a new toothbrush (OK, standard/boring), a superhero no cavities club sticker, and "high fives" from any staff that saw her that day.

A few months ago I had the pleasure of chatting with Lisa and her parents during a recall visit. She is now 20 years old. Through hard work (diet), persistence, and a solid oral health regimen, Lisa has remained cavity free for the last 10 years. Real life heroes seem in short supply these days. Here at the Children's Dental Health Clinic, patients like Lisa and her parents bless and inspire us; indeed, they are our superheroes.

Clinic Update

We are the only multi-specialty non-profit dental clinic for children and young adults in Greater Long Beach. We provide comprehensive dental treatment all under one roof for children and young adults (ages 0-21), including those who have severe dental decay, special needs and complex medical considerations such as Asthma, Autism, Cancer, Cerebral Palsy, Down Syndrome, HIV/AIDS, and Sickle Cell Anemia. Families who are turned away from other clinics unable to care for their children due to their age, poverty level, and mental or medical condition find a home at the CDHC. Thanks to our super hero supporters, we have been able to serve more than 10,000 underserved children, from birth to age 21, through 33,000 visits each year!



Main Clinic Heroes

The Main Clinic is an integrated dental home providing dynamic, multi-specialty dental care services that include General and Pediatric Dentistry, Preventive Dentistry, Oral Hygiene Education, Orthodontics, Endodontics, Periodontics, Oral Surgery, and treatment with Oral or Intravenous Sedation, or General Anesthesia. We are now a home to the state-of-the-art computer assisted scanning and milling technology system, the CEREC CAD/CAM, that allows us to provide crowns in

one visit, made possible by support from the **S. Mark Taper Foundation, Ahmanson Foundation, LA Care Health Plan, the Rose Hills Foundation, and Patterson Dental.**

Catalina Clinic Heroes

A generous donor, affectionately called our Avalon Angel, helps bring our heroic services to life at this rural, school-based clinic on Catalina Island, serving all children on the island who face issues accessing dental care. Our new three-operator clinic continues to provide dental treatment and is also equipped with an outdoor oral health education area. We cannot thank our Avalon Angel enough, along with all the (dental team) heroes who make this possible!

Early Intervention Heroes

For our youngest children, ages 0-5, the Early Intervention Program provides a solid foundation of understanding oral health as related to overall health by providing unique individual 30-minute sessions that include oral health assessment, toothbrush prophylaxis, fluoride application, and in-depth oral health and nutrition education. Over the past two years, this program has served close to 2,000 children and their families.



Mobile Dental Clinic Heroes

Thanks to funding from the **Annenberg Foundation**, we were able to give our Mobile Dental Clinic a fresh new look to represent our vibrant community. Each year, thousands of families and children receive free oral health education, dental screenings, oral health kits, and referral to care because of generous funders, such as **Molina Healthcare.**

Orthodontics Clinic Heroes

We continue to provide a premier Orthodontics Program that has provided thousands of children with beautiful smiles, including children with challenging restorative needs. We are proud of our work with the Cranio-Facial/Cleft Palate Teams at the **Miller Children's Hospital** and support these children who require complex and often lengthy treatment.

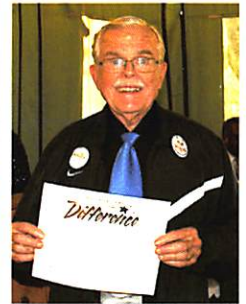

Premier Training at the CDHC



For over 15 years, under the dedicated supervision of our superhero Endodontist, Dr. George Bogen, who retired in August 2015, we have partnered with the Long Beach Veterans Administration Hospital to provide pediatric-specific training for their Endodontic Specialty Residents.

Dedicated dental professionals are the heart of any clinic practice and our CDHC family is a great example. We are passionate about being a premier training facility and have helped hundreds of dental professionals gain valuable, hands-on dental training experiences by working with a diverse population of children and young adults. Many of our past students, now working at their own practices, continue to come back to serve at the CDHC, citing our mission and belief that **every child deserves to smile.**

General and Pediatric Dental Residency Programs

We have completed our 25th year of collaboration with the **USC Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry** Pediatric Dental Residency Program. Over the past two years, our team of Residents grew from three Residents to four full-time Pediatric Dental Residents. They provide therapeutic and preventive treatment, including all levels of sedation, both in the Clinic and the Hospital Operating Room. Our Pediatric Dental Residents are also on-call 24/7 for oral health emergencies at **Miller Children's Hospital** and **Long Beach Memorial Medical Center**. Their advanced training makes them uniquely qualified to treat medically complex and/or special needs patients and the very young.



To further promote a comprehensive training experience, Pediatric Dental Residents from USC are on rotation through our Orthodontic Clinic. **Orthodontics training** helps provide Residents with a clear understanding of the needs of children with special medical considerations, especially those with facial anomalies, cleft-palate, and very young children who need specialized appliances for proper jaw and teeth development. In July 2013, the CDHC also became a training site for **General Practice Residents** of the **University of Southern California** and the **Los Angeles Department of Veterans Affairs**.



Allied Health Professional Training Programs

Our teaching family has grown with the addition of **West Coast University** Bachelor of Science Dental Hygiene students to provide treatment for our kids, as well as our longstanding commitment to **Cerritos College** Registered Dental Hygiene and Registered Dental Assistant Programs. We welcome the newest members of our CDHC family of training professionals!



Oral Health Education

Building oral health and hygiene knowledge for our patients and their families is a vital component to all our services and programs! Every patient receives oral health education. Oral Health Kits comprised of a toothbrush, tooth paste, floss and timer are also distributed to patients and families. Thanks to amazing support from groups such as the **Rotary Club of Whittier** (below), **Molina Healthcare**, **Children's Benefit League**, **South Bay Kaiser Permanente**, and **Soroptimist International of Long Beach** we were able to bring our services out into the community at health fairs and schools to serve thousands of children!

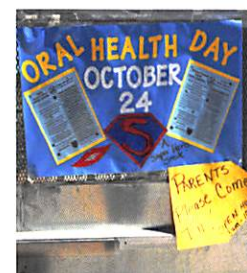
