With the DDF monies, the Del Mar-Solana Beach Rotary Club provided the \$750 registration fee for the Honduras team to participate in our Rotary MUN Conference this year. With the DDF monies, the San Diego Downtown Breakfast Rotary Club provided the \$750 registration fee for one of the Mexican teams to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference this year. With the remaining DDF monies, the La Jolla Golden Triangle Rotary Club provided the \$750 registration fee for the Peruvian team to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference this year. To comply with the DDF grant requirements, each of our Rotary Clubs sponsored at least one (1) local high school team and paid their \$750 registration fee for those teams to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference this year. In fact, each of our Rotary Clubs sponsored more than one (1) local MUN team and paid more than \$750 in MUN registration fees this year, far exceeding the DDF grant matching funds requirement. Please see the letters from each of our Rotary Clubs that are posted to the District Matching Grants site in conjunction with this Final Report that confirm these facts.

4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects:

The DDF grant allowed more international teams to participate in our 2017 Model UN Conference than ever before. Since these international teams also need to pay for their transportation costs to come to San Diego for the MUN Conference, many of them would not be able to afford the \$750 registration fee. In addition, we were very impressed with the performances of the Honduras, Mexico and Peruvian teams. The rest of the students really love meeting and making friends with students from other countries. The addition of the Honduras, Mexico and Peruvian teams this year has fueled enthusiasm among a growing number of US and Central American Rotarians to bring even more international teams to our 2018 Rotary Model UN Conference! We would greatly appreciate the opportunity to apply for another DDF grant for the 2017-18 year to help facilitate these additional international teams participating in our MUN next year.
