2. Name of District Grant - Scholarships for 24 Students in Kenya

 Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred (100 words or less.

The grant provided scholarships to underprivileged children to attend the Kiurani Secondary School located in the poverty-stricken area of Chogoria Kenya. The residents of Chogoria are extremely poor, living in mud and stone self-built structures with no electricity or running water. This grant supported 24 students for \$250 per child for one year in school. Each child has a sponsor who provides the \$250 to pay the school fees. Without this support these children would not be able to pay their fees and therefore not have a high school education. Without an education there is little hope that the child will be able to find work to support him or herself or the family. That was accomplished in October 2017.

4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects:

Rotary has sponsored children in this project for four years. The first club was the Sunshine Rotary in Healdsburg California. Many of these students have graduated and gone on to find jobs or attend a university. Now the Del Mar Solana Beach Rotary is also supporting 24 of the 62 children requesting help with school fees. Lessons learned are that we cannot help all of the children. Friends and family sponsor some students but there are never enough sponsors to pay for all of them. Thanks to the Rotary for helping these students.
