1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
As part of a Global Grant project to install water tanks in a village in Guatemala, our club purchased Rotary Club Plaques to place on the tanks to showcase rotary involvement in the project. 26 plaques were purchased.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 10 member of the international committee in addition to a minimum of 35 members in the club who through several fundraising events raised funds for the core project

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
Installed Rotary plaques set into Concrete walls of the support bases to our new water tank installation. Not all funds were expended. \$686.81 was expended of the \$1,000 grant. Additional funds were directed towards transportations costs that were part of the global grant.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 26 Families with an average of 4 per family plus extended families and close by neighbors.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The impact to the community for the Global Grant is for long term sanitation standards. The district Grant funds toward the wall plaques is for Long term recognition of the Rotary Club in this Guatemalan Community.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Imagine Guatemala helped to assist in the acquisition of labor to build the tanks and install the plaques and orchestrate the transportation.


