Project Description:
1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?
Food relief, valued at \$2,500, was distributed among 25 food insecure families, residing in the Pleasantville School District. On May 8th 2020, Pleasantville School Administrators discretely delivered \$100 worth of food relief to the homes of 25 needy families. Each delivery was accompanied by an inspirational message written by a Rotarian from the Rotary Club of Pleasantville
2. How many people benefited from this project? approximately 125 people benefited
3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?
The administrators of the Pleasantville School District were aware of 25 Pleasantville students, whose families suffered from elevated levels of food insecurity due to the Pandemic. These families had an average of 5 people each, therefore approximately 125 people had their hunger addressed through this project.
4. How many Rotarians participated in the project?
5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.
The Pleasantville Rotarians selected the items to donate and issued a check, using previously raised funds, for \$2,375. (In return, we obtained \$2,500 worth of food due to a 5% discount awarded by Wakefern Food Corp.)
The Pleasantville Rotarians also wanted to distribute the food relief packages themselves but were not able to due to the school district's privacy restrictions and due to Covid-19 safety precautions.
As a result, 20 members wrote inspirational messages that were dispersed with each food relief delivery.
6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
The administrators of the Pleasantville School District were able to reliably identify the families in need and to later serve as a confidential and discrete delivery service to address the hunger of the local needy children and their families.
