  - A: Meridian Rotary Club approached the City of Meridian Parks & Recreation, inviting them to the club to choose a park project for club collaboration. The pedestrian park drinking fountain was chosen. Five Rotarians lead the project with the support of 12 others who supported the fundraising. 4 Rotarians managed the financial planning, fundraising, chose the fountain, and worked with the Parks Planning Team. The newly developed pedestrian park is on Pine Street in Meridian, ID on the walking/biking trail system in an under-served area of the city and is in the heart of the trail system that is being developed in phases. The water fountain was installed in April 2021, after the weather improved; the Rotary plaque was installed on 5-10-2021.
- 4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there?
  - A: The citizens of Meridian, population 125,000, who use the pedestrian walking/biking system in the City of Meridian are the beneficiaries.
- 5. How many Rotarians participated in the project?
  - A: 16 Rotarians participated in the project.

- A: Rotarians worked with the City parks team on planning for the water fountain location, decided on the type of drinking fountain, worked collaboratively with the City personnel on installation.

  A: The physical installation of the drinking Fountain was completed under the supervision of the City of Meridian, Parks & Recreation, and their plumbing/water experts who tapped into the City of Meridians potable water system.
