Dear Rotary Club of Kalispell,

The COVID-19 global health crisis strained resources for not only our most at risk such as seniors, disabled individuals, and children it also impacted people that would have never thought they would be in line for food to support their families. Thanks to the Rotary Club of Kalispell and the grant for \$5,000 we received helped us to put food into the vehicles that came through our curbside distribution. During 2020 across all of our feeding programs we served over 28,000 households and over 78,000 people which does not include supporting other food banks, community organizations, or other counties that were in crisis. Over the year we double the amount of food out of doors from 1.7 million in 2019 to 3.4 million pounds with an overhead cost of 1.8% meaning that 98.2% of all money went into programs. The \$5,000 grant from Rotary originally projected our meal cost at .60 a meal but we were able to stretch that donation to .53 a meal allowing us to put out 9,434 meals. Thank you so much for helping us feed our community during one of the most difficult years.
