1.	1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and wh						
	the beneficiaries? List any changes that might have occurred.						

The Community Services of Hinsdale requested the bulk purchase of toilet paper to support the new levels of demand the service was/is experiencing. Hinsdale Rotary determined that a \$2000 bulk purchase would satisfy the CSH's immediate needs. The bulk purchase was made by CSH, an invoice was received, and Hinsdale Rotary paid for the purchase. The purchase was made in Hinsdale, IL. The beneficiaries of this donation at the hundreds of people seeking food and supply relief during the Covid 19 pandemic through Hinsdale Community Services.

The Plymouth Place of LaGrange (retirement center) has set up a food bank for its employees. The concept is that employees will be able to easily and safely obtain the food they need after working, and avoiding having to go to public stores for groceries. This, first of all, is a great convenience to each shift working at the center, but also it enables the Plymouth Place employees to obtain quality foods without subjecting themselves to possible Covid 19 infections in public grocery stores.

Hinsdale Rotary was contacted by Western Spring Rotary requesting that we support this project. Our remaining District Grant \$631.00, or the original \$2,631.00 was sent to Plymouth Place as part of the \$10,000 that Western Spring Rotary was trying to raise for the Plymouth Place Employee Food Pantry.

One, myself, Tom Norton, President, with concurrence from the Board of the Hinsdale Rotary Club

2. What did they do? Please give at least 2 examples.

I was contacted by both the Hinsdale Community Services for the toilet paper purchase and the Western Spring Rotary on the Plymouth Place Employee Food Bank. I put both of these concepts before our Board of 13.

3. How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project?

Uncertain.

At the Hinsdale Community Services, hundreds are served each week. On the donation, every family applying for food received two rolls of toilet paper per two week cycle, instead of one.

At the Plymouth Place Employee Food Bank, Plymouth Place lists 180 employees. Every employee is eligible to draw grocery supplies from the Employee Food Bank.

- 4. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?
  - -Better personal hygiene in the time of Covid 19 for the clients of the Hinsdale Community Service.
  - -Convenience and safer shopping for the employees of the LaGrange Plymouth Place.
