Immediate Needs for Survivors of Human Trafficking in Alaska

Project Funds Breakdown: Total Funds - \$10,000

\$3,000 :: Fred Meyer Gift Cards to Meet the Immediate Needs of Survivors

These gift cards are used to help survivors meet their immediate needs. The reason we use Fred Meyer is that survivors can cover a wide range of needs in one location. From food and clothing to hygiene and personal items. These cards are a lifeline for our survivors who have immediate needs!

\$3,000 :: Medical / Counseling Assistance for Survivors

Every survivor that comes to our program has experienced significant physical and mental abuse. Helping them heal and overcome their past can often mean medical assistance and/or counseling to deal with the trauma they have experienced. These fund help cover those necessary costs.

\$3,000 :: Housing Assistance for Survivors

As our survivors work to rebuild their lives, one of the most critical steps is securing safe housing. Many times survivors need rent assistance or help with security deposit in order to get in to and keep housing. These funds are used to ensure they have a safe and secure place to live.

\$1,000 :: Transportation Assistance for Survivors

Many survivors need help with transportation costs. This could be bus fare or gas money to ensure they are able to make it to drug and alcohol treatment, counseling appointments, work or other necessary appointments.
