The gift cards distributed will help to purchase not only toys but many times we see purchases of winter clothing.

- 7. How did you share the news of your project?


We discussed and celebrated this project several times within our club, the President shared our success at the monthly Presidents meeting and we have this project listed as an effort that we are involved with on our club website.
