 Purchase and stuff backpacks with grade-appropriate school supplies for 50 students of LOT 318, a non-profit program focused on under-served youth in an at-risk community in the city of Placentia, CA. Backpacks and school supplies were distributed on 8/28/2020, just prior to start of the academic year.
