Oak View Youth Soccer League is open to players between the ages of 4 and 16 of all skill levels. The cost is \$25 per year for 18 games per season with 2 seasons in the year. OVYSL is largely a volunteer-based soccer league with several hundred students from around Huntington Beach and surrounding areas. Oak View is an underserved, largely Latino-based community in Huntington Beach. The club's contribution through donation of equipment, jerseys, time, and volunteer support will allow more students participate by keeping costs low.
