

Final Report on the Clara Clinic, District project # 3645

The Clinic administrator, Flaria Felix Faraji, has provided the following information:

During the following periods, the Clinic earned: (converted from Tanzanian shillings)

June-July	\$386.14
August	\$227.96
September	\$308.23
October	\$377.80

As of 2/26/21, the Clinic has served 183 male and 291 female patients, most of whom are unable to pay. Student groups have been hosted for health seminars, study tours, and measurements of height and weight.

The funds we sent were spent as follows:

Supplemental floor, doors, and windows for the doctors' house*	\$2100
Medication for patients	\$1200
Equipment	\$1200
Payments to Doctors and Nurses (for 4 months)	\$2400
Held for electrical service (application submitted to local Government) to operate equipment.	<u>\$3100</u>
TOTAL	\$10,000

I have been in communication with Mama Faraji throughout this period. She has expressed her gratitude and that of the staff over and over.

*The doctors' house was unanticipated but was built so that the doctors did not need to travel great distances daily to serve the Clinic which would increase their costs.,
