We worked with the Theodore Young Community Center where we worked with them packing bags of food and supplies for families, then delivering them. This project is complete.

Shut in Seniors and Families were the beneficiaries. We supplied food & supplies that they were unable to go out and purchase for themselves.

Every Thursday they worked with the volunteers at the Community Center to pack the bags of groceries and supplies. Then they were assigned delivery routes and they delivered the bags.
