Project Title Successful Remote Learning for Early Childhood and Elementary Age Kids

The Club held 2 remote sessions for parents on how to deal with the social and emotional impact of remote learning on their early ed and elementary age kids. A total of 20 participants came to both sessions. Those that wanted to get a mask decorating kit for their children got one mailed to them. The Club also donated a total of 21 books to two local Elementary School Libraries that the Club has worked with extensively and the Little Free Libraries in town. The book was entitled Modaff and Miff and is about coping with worries <https://www.modaffandmiff.com/>

6 Rotarians from the Club were active with this project.

Our Member Stacey Montgomery lead both the sessions, contacted the author and school principals and arranged for the book donation. Rotarian Mera Johnson applied for the grant, coordinated and marketed the events and provided technical support for the events.
4. How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project?
The 20 families that attended the event. And the children who read the books in the school Library and the Little Free Libraries. This is harder to quantify however there are a total of 650 children at both Elementary Schools and the Libraries are free for use in the Community.

The impact was assistance to parents. Many children are struggling and having social and emotional issues related to remote learning. The seminars provided much needed advice to parents on how to approach this topic.

Krug Elementary and Nicholson Elementary received the books and have them available in their LRC

We advertised on Facebook. In local education related groups and through our Club.
