Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? Construction of toilet block for school in Jinja, Uganda. Funds purchased supplies and construction costs for toilets at school and community water tank for hand washing. This is the first toilet block of its kind for the village. Primarily build for the students, the toilet block benefits 300 members in the village and school students of 172. This has been a model project for the villagers and prompted further water and sanitation awareness.

Construction started May 12, 2021 in Jinja, Uganda.
