The Dream Center is a residential recovery facility that helps young women and men overcome substance abuse, physical and emotional struggles associated with their life in human sex trafficking. The facility was a converted old motel that had extremely dilapidated surroundings. This was very counterproductive to the rehabilitative program. The Rotary Club of Scottsdale was also involved in the rehabilitation of the Dream Center with a global grant. Once funds were secured, plans were coordinated with Dale Ross (Scottsdale RC); and RC Verrado's grant monies were transferred to Scottsdale RC Foundation to facilitate renovations arranged by that Club.
