The Pocatello Club successfully engaged Wendy Blome, Chairman of the Board of Directors for the Spafford Children's Center, who visited our club via ZOOM. We subsequently raised enough money from club members and through the district grant process to sponsor 33 palestinian children who were able to attend school this year at the SCC in East Jerusalem. Over the course of the past 9 months we have received regular reports of the progress of these students including one video of them listening to club member Amy Campbell reading English children's stories to their English Class. While the project is technically completed, there are still several club members of our club that continue to work with SCC by reading books and keeping in touch with the Spafford Center.

4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there?

Thirty three Palestinian Children and their families living in East Jerusalem received tuition assistance and were direct beneficiaries of this grant.

Twenty five members of our club directly participated in this project either by making a monetary donation or by reading and recording children's stories to be used in their English classes.

Dear Mr. Kirkham:

I thank you and the members of the Pocatello Rotary Club for your support of the Spafford Children's Center (SCC) in East Jerusalem. Through your donation of \$3,312 to the American Friends of the Spafford Children's Center (AFSCC) 40 children have been able to receive tutoring at SCC in Arabic, English, or math for an 11-week semester. These classes are critical to the children as they have lost valuable school time due to the pandemic and many were without internet access and computers. At the SCC the teacher creates an individualized plan to meet the needs, and build on the strengths, of each child. In classes of two or three the students make amazing progress. At the end of 11 weeks the child is assessed again and most children have gained one or more grade levels and many return to SCC for another semester.

The videotaped stories the Pocatello Rotary Club sent to the SCC will soon be part of the curriculum for the English teacher and her students. The way the videos were edited so that the children can see the entire page as the story is read to them will be so helpful to the teacher.

I hope that the partnership between the AFSCC, SCC, and your club will continue in the new year.
