Project Title	Give Dictionaries to Schools						
Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? List any changes that might have occurred.							

The Joliet Rotary club purchased over 2400 dictionaries to be handed out at to 3rd and 4th graders in the school district. This year we were asked to purchase 2 years of dictionaries as last year we did not hand these out because of COVID. Nearly 20 Joliet Rotarians were involved in presenting these dictionaries and putting the 4-way stickers in the front of each book. When we handed out these books to the students we talked about using the books as a tool and explained how the 4-way test is used in the life of Rotarians. For many of these children this is the only book they own or are given throughout the school year as this is a low income school district.

The club spent over \$9000 (see attached receipts) on the books and spent over 40 hours of community service handing out these books and transporting them all to the various schools.

The Joliet Club is requesting, because of the extra cost for doing 2 years, that the district funds be used to offset approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ of the overall expense. This would replace grant # 3868 and grant # 3866 as both of these projects were either canceled because of COVID or weather. It would enhance grant # 3867 which was previously approved.

How many Rotarians participated in the project?
