1. What types of grants must be submitted on www.matchinggrants.org? Please go to www.matchinggrants.org and look at one of your projects or one from another club. What is the current status of this project? All District Grants must be submitted on matchinggrants.org. The current status of one of Greeley, Colorado's projects is paid.
2. Go to the district web site and look for information on when grant applications are due. When are district grant applications due? When are Governors grant applications due? When are global grant application due? District Grants due 6/3/22. Governors grants due 10/7/2022
Global grants: no deadline.
3. What are the qualification requirements to be eligible for a District grant? Governor's grant?

To be eligible for District Grants:

- Clubs must attend attend Qualification training at PETS and must complete the [Club Qualification](#) on the District 5440 website
- Clubs must have it's annual Foundation giving goal entered in Rotary Club Central.
- Clubs must have per capita Foundation giving of at least \$50.
- Clubs Must not have any overdue grant reports
- Clubs must not have any open grants older than two years from issuance of DDF funds.

Governor's Grant Eligibility: Rotary and Rotaract Clubs wishing to apply for a Governor's grant must be contributing \$50 or more per capita to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund to be eligible for a \$1,000 grant

4. What is your annual fund goal for 2022/23? \$12,300
5. Have you entered this goal on Rotary Club Central? Yes.
6. What is your plan for meeting this goal (club dues, fundraiser, matching points campaign, etc)?
Fundraisers and several programs on it.

7. What is the DDF match and maximum match for each of the following types of grants:

Governor's grant Governor's Grant Eligibility: Rotary and Rotaract Clubs wishing to apply for a Governor's grant must be contributing \$50 or more per capita to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund to be eligible for a \$1,000 grant

District grant To provide a more equitable distribution of available funds, there are three tiers of Rotary Club eligibility for District Grants as follows:

- Tier 1 – Clubs who contribute \$200 or more per capita to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund will be eligible for \$6,000.
- Tier 2 – Clubs who contribute between \$100 and \$199 per capita to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund will be eligible for \$5,000.
- Tier 3 – Clubs who contribute between \$50 and \$99 per capita to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund will be eligible for \$3,500.
- Tier 4 - Clubs who contribute less than \$50 per capita to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund will not be eligible for district grants or governor's grants.

Global grant \$15000

8. What grants requires a club to set up a separate bank account for grant funds? Global.
9. What can you do as club president to ensure that bank statements and receipts are kept for all projects funded by grants from the district or TRF? Stay in contact with Grant committee as well as club Treasurer for current status.
10. If your club has contributed \$150/capita to the Rotary Foundation Annual fund in 2021/22, what is the maximum amount of grant funds you can get for a district grant in 2022/23? \$5000

11. Can your club use a Governor's grant for an undergraduate scholarship? District Scholarship Grant: Rotary Clubs in Tiers 1, 2 and 3 may use their Governor's Grant for an undergraduate scholarship for a student who has demonstrated interest in one of Rotary's six areas of focus or for RYLA scholarships.

12. When does a District grant final report need to be completed and where do you download the completed form? (HINT: see D5440 Grants Terms and Conditions)? How often are district grant history logs updated? 30 days after final completion. Grant history logs updated with each new information entered.

13. When are Global grant progress reports and final reports due? Where are these submitted? (HINT: See Rotary Grants Terms and Conditions) due upon completion.
