Either the Club Members will deliver the items and meet the clients/youth as they make the household supplies delivery or the delivery will be made to the offices of Crittenton for distribution by Crittenton staff. Club Members will forward the receipt(s) to Project Leader Judy Booth who will vet them and pass copies to Tim Mullahey, the Club Treasurer. He will write a check of reimbursement to the Club Member. Project Leader Judy Booth will submit progress and final report with proper documentation in accord with the grant requirements.
