Project Title Dictionary Project -2021

- 1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? List any changes that might have occurred. The original project was to distribute dictionaries to each 3rd and 4th grade student. However, the teachers did not want the dictionaries. Instead, the club purchased up to five books for each third grade in-class library and each class received a copy of "Our Class is a Family" by Susan Olsen. In total 108 books were provided to the district. Each student also received a Rotary based bookmark.
- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 12
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least 2 examples. Krista Simpson, who works for the school district, spearheaded the project for the club by collaborating with the teachers regarding their book selections, ordering the books, distributing the book, acting as a liaison between the club and school district and club and Interact Club. She was able to provide the initial feedback from the teachers regarding the dictionaries and many other things. Most of the club was involved with which book to select. One of the club's Rotarians did the research to provide the choices selected by the club. Several Rotarians, led by the club president, attended, and assisted with the presentation to the school board. Several Rotarians were involved with the grant administration
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project? **475 initially**
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The books will be available to about 475 third graders a year for years to come. The teacher specifically chose the books to best suit the educational needs of their students.
- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Valley View 365U School District and Romeoville High School Interact Club assisted with the project. The school district allowed the club to partnership with the project, one of the club's Rotarians works for RHS and allowed her to gather information for the books for each class, purchase the books for the club and have staff distribute them to all the third-grade classrooms. The school district collaborated with the club to design, produce and distribute at no cost to the club Four Way Test based bookmarks to each third-grade student.

The Interact Club put "Donated by Romeoville Rotary Club" stickers in all the books and assisted with other matters.

7. How did you share the news of your project? The club and school district produced a video that was shared with each class, the club made a presentation to the school board that is shown on local public access in Bolingbrook and Romeoville. Information pertaining to the project was placed on Facebook.
