We provide \$1,000 scholarships to 2 high school graduates going on to college. Recipients are identified through an application several pages long, asking their educational success, their involvement in extracurricular activities, and their experience with direct service to the school and community. Recipients were Aiden Carroll and Alina Miles.

- 3. What did they do? Please give at least 2 examples.

Rotary members included our high school principal, who publicized the application to students who may have need. Three members of the club read every application and score each one on a grid. Officers of the club wrote the check and welcomed the students to a meeting to share their story.

- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project? One recipient has been active in the Interact Club at our high school. The other has not been involved with Rotary, but has done other service in our communiity.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

It supports our Interact club, gives awareness of Rotary, and encourages young people to pursue a college education, which in the long term serves our community.

- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? We cooperate with the high school in Manteno.
- How did you share the news of your project? We shared pictures of the recipients on our website and Facebook page, and we presented the scholarship at the high school awards ceremony.
