1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?  
Providing an environmental alternative solution for Sophomore, Junior & Senior HS Students by rethinking their daily use of single use plastic water bottles and the environmental waste issue they create . Orange Plaza Club purchased 135 Stainless Steel Premium Water Bottles and presented them to the El Modena HS students of the Digital Marketing Collaborative Class (DMC), their Teachers/Staff, non-Rotarian & OPR mentors. The DMC class customized each SS Bottle with their Class logo and OPR logo.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. A special in Class presentation was provided to the EIMo HS students on rethinking their use of single use plastics (SUP) and awareness to the environmental impact of their generation and how to implement, and change their behavior with SUP's

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? This project can move from a small group of mentored students (OPR ten month service project) towards the entire campus. Since the DMC students have designed the first batch of SS Bottles, this may provide their class the opportunity to offer all EIMo Students to purchase and have DMC custom design bottles for each of the student groups from sports, drama, clubs, etc.  
The students can educate their parents, sibliings and friends about the environmental issues with SUP's and make wise buying decisions from purchasing SUP's for the future.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? El Modena High School provided the school library for our monthly meeting know as Mentor Meals. OPR would pair up with the assigned Junior class and use a prepared curriculum by teaching staff and OPR to mentor, discuss, engage these students.
