Project Description

1.Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The purpose of the project is to provide wheelchairs to impoverished people in Parras, Mexico. At this point, our club (along with the Grapevine Rotary)has completed funding of the project. The Parras Rotary Club has ordered 240 wheelchairs from the United Rotary Fund of Mexico, has made the initial payment of \$17,000, and is awaiting confirmation of the date the container will arrive in Manzanillo. Beneficiaries will be impoverished people of the Parras area.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? <u>15</u>

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

About 15 Rotarians were involved in raising the funds. Two Rotarians completed and reviewed the grant application, and wired funding to the Parras club. Once the wheelchairs arrive, we will go to Parras to participate in the wheelchair distribution.

Impoverished people will be given the gift of mobility. This benefits not only the wheelchair recipient, but all the caretakers of that person. The project also includes wheelchair repair equipment so the wheelchairs can be maintained going forward.

The Wheelchair Foundation is the organization from which the Parras club actually orders the wheelchairs. The Rotary United Fund of Mexico is the importing entity.
