Project Description

Rotarians will purchase dictionaries and labels with the Four Way Test to put in the books.

A club meeting was dedicated to talking about our Dictionary project and we put labels in the dictionaries. Members of 4 Rotarians visited each school and spoke at an assembly to the students and staff about Rotary, the four way test, and some activities where the students used the dictionaries

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The students will use the books in the classroom to learn correct spelling, pronunciation, and meaning of the words they will be using in the classrooms to develop academic vocabulary. The non-English speaking students can take them home to share with their families and improve language development in the home. Learning English will empower the family member to enter the job market and improve their economic status.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

We met with all of the elementary schools and asked if they felt that dictionaries were making an impact on student learning. They all agreed that they wanted to have the dictionaries again this year. They had assemblies of all 3rd grade students and staff and let us talk about Rotary and the Four Way Test.
