- 2. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

Estes Valley Investment in Childhood Success (EVICS) staff have noticed that when Hispanics/Latinos migrate to the US without knowing how to speak the language nor write it, their children attend school and learn their new language (which is great, and EVICS is promoting that as well), yet it creates a gap in the family's communication and can lead to a disconnect within the parent-child relationship. When the parent who does not speak English, speaks Spanish to their kids, the kids answer back in English. To support parent-child and overall family connection EVICS created content and kits that promote a family time of listening, reading, and doing a fun craft activity together as family. The kits and materials were distributed at the Estes Park Elementary School, the Estes Valley Library and EVICS. The program focused on the Hispanic Community, but it is beneficial to the community in general.

The entire community of Estes Park has benefited from this program through collaboration among several partners to promote and support access to the books. The book titles are beneficial and appropriate for children infant through Second grade. The program specifically targets Kindergarten through Second Grade children with all Kindergarten students at the Estes Park Elementary School being read the book and given the accompanying activity kit to take home. Its goal is to support these families and create the habit to pause, read a book, and do an activity together every month to support family bonding and communication.

- 7. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role?
 - Rotary Club of Estes Park provided the funding for the project.
 - Macdonald Book Shop sold us the books for the kits at a discounted price.
 - Estes Valley Library received a socio-emotional backpack that is available for check out from that location.
 - Estes Park Elementary School received 75 bilingual kits every month for 5 months and 4 socio-emotional backpacks to be checked out by families from that location.
