Project Title Literacy Project

This was a District-wide Literacy service project that was done during the April 30 District Conference. District 6450 Rotarians are collected 200 gently used children's books and purchased 217 new children's books to provide to a local women's shelter, a day care center and foster care agency. The books were brought to the District Conference in Hinsdale on April 30, where Rotarians labeled the books and subsequently delivered them to Guardian Angels (Joliet), Childcare Center of Joliet Township High School and Easter Seals of Kankakee. Project funds were used to purchase new children's books and labels.

Rotarians collected gently used books, labeled new books and used books and delivered the books to the recipient agencies.
