Project: Ukraine Children's Mental Health

As Ukraine was headed into its second winter with increased bombings, more time spent in bomb shelters, intermittent electricity at best, and often no running water or heat, the children across Ukraine were increasingly sad and depressed. In the eastern part of the country where many are orphaned and in hospitals, it is epidemic. UAid Direct supplies many schools, hospitals and orphanages with food, clothing, hygiene, medical and other supplies, medicine, equipment and more. As the UAid Direct team was delivering this aid across the country, they saw these children and were determined to help.

We first spied James entertaining children in the Tesco refugee center on the Poland-Ukraine border in Summer 2022. We saw first-hand the joy he brought to children there and enlisted his skills immediately.
