This was Deck building project for a Naperville Resident, Carol Sierzega, who is disabled and survives on her Social Security income. The club gathered together and rebuilt Carol's 20X20 Cedar deck off the back of her house. The project was expanded to include a garden clean-up project for St. Patrick's Residence which is a rehabilitation senior community served by the Carmelite Sisters for the Aged and Infirm which consisted of manpower to do fall clean up and planting of a new red maple tree
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 12-15 Rotarians participated in the project
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples. 2-3 members supplied and purchased materials. All participating Rotarians assisted in the building of the Deck from measuring, cutting, carting materials etc. Additionally members assisted with Landscaping efforts in the clean up of both Carol's property and minor new landscaping needs in addition to clean up of the Carmelite Sisters home garden and the planting of a red maple tree.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Carol Sierzega benefited from the work at her residence as well as numerous residents of the Carmelite Sister' St Patrick's Residence.
