Students from two schools were identified and partook in a RYLA day on April 30, 2022. This was a successful experience for those who attended. The two clubs (Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary in conjunction with the e-club de Noroeste Global) will expand the program to double the number of students (aim for 100), increase both the scope of the experience by including more active participation of the ROTARY (MBSR and e-club) members with the faculty and splitting the the students from the schools into small groups to work together to solve topics (patterned after the District 5320's RYLA). Some students will have transportation costs to attend.

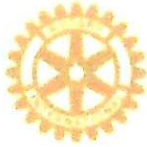
