The District 6450 Community Service Committee hosted a bed build for Sleep in Heavenly Peace in Tinley Park on June 18 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The District raised over \$6000 funds to purchase lumber needed to build the beds. Rotarian volunteers sanded, assembled and stained the beds. The beds were set up in 4 pieces and will be put together at the recipients' home. The finished beds are provided to 3-17 year-old victims of fire, flooding, domestic abuse relocation, and financial struggles.

This is part of the District-wide Empower Girls Initiative.
