The purpose of the grant was two-fold:

Item 1. To fund one \$1750 scholarships for GCISD needs-based scholarships (matched by TCC) students to attend Tarrant County College. Total of \$1750. The primary activity was cutting a check to the Tarrant County College Foundation.

Item 2. to provide third grade students GCISD with student Dictionaries. \$325. The project involved ordering and receiving the dictionaries; having labels made to identity the donors as the Rotary Clubs of Colleyville and Grapevine; attaching the labels to the inside cover of the dictionaries; and delivering the dictionaries to the various elementary school in GCISD.

Four Colleyville Rotarians participated in delivering the dictionaries to the schools.

The Grapevine Colleyville School Board approved the content of the dictionaries, and the schools assisted in coordinating delivery of the dictionaries.
