Project Title: RYLA Stephenville City Park

Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

On June 17, 2023, for a third time, RYLA participants worked with the City of Stephenville, Texas, to further develop and improve its City Park.

On June 6, 2023, Stephenville Rotary President Kristi Adams, along Assistant District Governor Moumin Quazi, presented a check for \$3000 (\$1500 from the Club matched by the District's \$1500), to Mayor Doug Svien at the Stephenville City Council Meeting.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? The entire Stephenville Club contributed to their \$1500 contribution by participating in their flag-posting fundraiser, which involved 13 Club members who posted and picked up American flags on major holidays (at least seven throughout the year). We also made the official presentation to the City (as noted above). Working with RYLA, the Stephenville Club (particularly Moumin Quazi, Kristi Adams, and Keith Stripling) worked with the City and the Stephenville ISD to coordinate the RYLA efforts with the City, its school district, and its parks and recreation coordinator Darren Trussell. We are disappointed to report that the City has been slow to deposit our check, so we are still awaiting a cancelled check and bank statement to reflect our donation. The City has sent us an acknowledgment of receipt of our check. We have pressured the City to give us an update, which we are still awaiting.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Flags posted (e.g., Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Armed Forces Day, etc.), plus a formal presentation to the City on June 6.

4. How many Non-Rotarians participated in the project? 4 spouses

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The City has changed their plans and is now moving its all-inclusive park to the main City Park (rather than the Collins Street Trailhead). The City has assured us that the \$3000 will be matched and will contribute to the completion of the all-inclusive park. Also, RYLA worked with the City successfully on June 17, planting shrubs in the medians of the City Park.

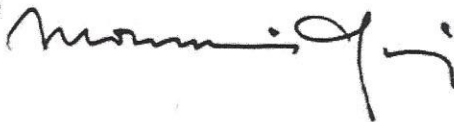
