 Student Dictionaries to third grade students in Mesa and Gilbert Public Schools and San Tan Charter School in Gilbert.

When (dates) and where (city, state and country) did project activities take place? School census taken in early August based on enrollments, dictionaries ordered, Rotary stickers applied August 18, 2023, in Gilbert and Mesa, Arizona, USA. Dictionaries delivered to 37 schools in Gilbert and Mesa between August 21, 2023 and October 20, 2023. Eleven schools had formal presentations; the remaining schools were just delivered to the students by the schools at their request.

Who were the beneficiaries? 3,264 third grade students and their teachers

- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 19 Rotarians and 11 non-Rotarians worked on stickering. 5 Rotarians made presentations to schools
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotary emblem and Four Way Test stickers were applied to the dictionaries. Dictionaries were delivered to the schools and, when permitted, presentations were made to the students about Rotary's role in their community, the transition from learning to read to reading to learn and need to know what words mean, how they are spelled and pronounced. The information in a dictionary includes much more than words, including American history, math tables, periodic table of elements, sign language and geography.
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 3,250 individuals.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Higher academic achievement, better performance on standardized testing and increased awareness of Rotary as a positive influence in the community.
